- A non working/fake organization
- Asking people for membership fees

- Ask other people do they now about the organization?

## You are the boss scam

- Starting organization using your skills resources with their small money

- They show that you taking big money but, you don't get even fraction of it

- Will take your brand under their name in contract
- Will use you as their spy for getting other's information
